## Parent & Caregiver Code of Conduct

- Uphold the Association Constitution and by-laws as presented on our [website](#) and by-law books issued each year.
- Encourage but do not force children to participate.
- Focus upon efforts and performances rather than the overall outcome of an event. This assists young players in setting realistic goals related to their ability by reducing the emphasis on winning. Teach young players that honest effort is as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Encourage participation according to the rules.
- Never ridicule or yell at a player for making a mistake.
- Remember that young players participate in organized sport for their enjoyment not yours.
- Young players learn best from example. Applaud good play by all teams.
- If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the official's judgment and honesty in public. Remember that most officials give their time and effort for your child's involvement.
