

Player Permit Policy

The South Australian Spirit of Cricket pledge

We are committed to creating an enduring legacy for South Australian cricket, by ensuring it is played with honour, dignity and respect, and providing a fun and safe environment for all.

South Central Junior Cricket Association has a commitment to the Spirit of Cricket, and all that it stands for applies not only to the Laws of the Game, but is also fundamental when applying our competition bylaws and playing conditions. We encourage all clubs, players and supporters to uphold this commitment to the Spirit of Cricket.

It is the policy of the South Central Junior Cricket Association (SCJCA) that all players must be selected to their correct team, based on their playing age on the 1st September at the commencement of the playing season.

SCJCA recognises that there are times where exceptions to this rule may apply and a permit request may be granted. Conditions for this are:

- 1. Players with a medical condition.
- 2. If a player has a movement or learning disability.
- 3. If a player requires further development in their skills, where playing at a higher level may e of detriment to that player, the Club will be required to show evidence of such
- 4. Girls may play 1 year older to further support development.

To apply for a permit exception the following process occurs:

- 1. Players' must be registered to MyCricket
- 2. Players with a medical condition will be required to show proof via a medical certificate from a General Practitioner
- 3. Girls may be older in any grade, as long as SCJCA is notified via the permit form
- 4. A club may be asked to provide evidence and supporting statements as a further extension to the request form.

Playing conditions surround the permits and are, but not limited to:

- 1. Monitoring of player's performance will form part of the permit
 - a. These will be reviewed regularly by SCJCA permit co-ordinator.
- 2. Permits may be revoked at any time.

All playing permits are to be managed by the Permits Co-ordinator with the support of SCJCA.
